*Each applicant must :	
1) Be currently enrolled at a non-Japanese academic institution with which we have a student exchange agreement.	
2) Agree to leave Kyoto University and return to their home institution upon completion of the exchange program.	
3) Have excellent academic and personal records.	
4) Have a specific purpose for studying in Japan.	

REQUIREMENTS	
Language Proficiency	For those who take courses in Japanese: Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level N1 or an equivalent level For those who take courses in English: TOEFL iBT 79 (or equivalent IELTS score) or higher *It is preferable to have simple conversation skills in Japanese for making life in Japan smoother and easier.
Application Documents	1. Application Form (Form 1, 2, 3-1, 3-2, 4, 5) 2. One Certificate of Enrollment 3. One Original Academic Transcript 4. One Passport Copy (the page with your photo, name, and passport number) 5. One Copy of the Official Certificate or Score Report of Japanese or English Proficiency Test 6. Two photos (see "Photo Requirement")
Application Procedure	Nomination: The student's home institution nominates an exchange applicant(s) via email with the following information. - Applicant's name - Applicant's entrance year and end date of enrollment period - Period of exchange Application: Applicants submit the application documents to their home institution. Applicants' home institution sends the application documents to Kyoto University by courier. *It is desirable to send us the application documents via email first before you send them out by courier.

STUDY AT KYOTO UNIVERSITY

International Exchange Student	We accept exchange students from our partner institutions based on the student exchange agreement as "Special Auditor" which is a non-degree seeking status at Kyoto University's Faculty of Agriculture.
Tuitions	Based on the student exchange agreement, students will be exempted from the examination fee, matriculation fee, and tuition at Kyoto University.

Restrictions	- Undergraduate students can't take courses offered to graduate students. - Minimum number of courses to take per semester: 7 courses including a maximum of two Japanese language courses. - Maximum credits to earn: 40 credits per year - Permission is required in advance to join seminars, experimental work, etc.

INSURANCE

*After enrollment at Kyoto University, exchange students are required to have the following insurance:	
Health Insurance (Mandatory)	National Health Insurance: approximately 2,000 yen per month https://kuiso.oc.kyoto-u.ac.jp/en/life/resident/
Personal Accident Insurance (Mandatory)	Gakkensai: (Premium) 1,000 yen for one year coverage Personal Liability Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research Compensation for unexpected accidents during commute, extracurricular activities, and education/research activities at Kyoto University. https://www.kyoto-u.ac.jp/en/current/campus-life/health-management-and-insurance-1/insurance-programs-for-ku-students
Personal Liability Insurance (Mandatory)	GAKUBAI: (Premium) approximately 2,000 yen for one year (Univ. Co-op Membership fee) 4,000 yen Coverage for the insured party's legal liability for bodily injury or property damage caused to a third party Apply at Kyoto University Co-op. *The membership fee is refundable by taking necessary procedures before leaving Kyoto University. https://www.s-coop.net/english/
*Before arrival in Japan:	
Others	Overseas Travel Insurance: It is desirable to buy travel insurance with coverage for the entire duration of stay in Japan to ensure adequate coverage. In case of any emergency, we recommend students to bring along sufficient funds. (There was a case that a student had an operation and needed to settle a huge amount of medical fees temporarily.)
