Qualification of Applicant	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The applicant must be a resident/citizen of Republic of China. The candidate shall be aged less than 31 years old.</li><li>2. The applicant must be a student who has obtained an undergraduate degree from universities in Taiwan. Students from low income families will be given priority.</li><li>3. The applicant must obtain a Japan Student Visa prior to his/her arrival in Japan. For those who hold other Japanese long-term visa must give up the said visa in advance.</li><li>4. Male applicant must have completed his military services obligation in Taiwan; or who has had the obligation of military services waived.</li><li>5. The applicant must obtain the enrollment admission to a PhD program from GSA, Kyoto U</li><li>6. The applicant must not receive other scholarships/grants of the same nature at the same period as the TGET scholarship.</li><li>7. The applicant must pass the Test of JLPT Certificate of N1 Level. For English-Taught Program: the applicant must pass the Test of JLPT Certificate of N2 Level and either TOEFL 85 or above, or IELTS 6.5 or above.</li><li>8. The applicant must be a person with personal integrity and with international vision.</li><li>9. The applicant must fully understand the purpose of the TGET Scholarship and positively promote the international image of Taiwan, R.O.C.</li></ol>

Certificate of acceptance from the PhD programs of GSA, Kyoto U. For English-taught Program, a letter of permission from GSA, Kyoto U advising professor to teach in English</li><li>6. Copy of JLPT certificate of N1 level; or Copy of JLPT certificate of N2 level and either TOEFL 85 or above, or IELTS 6.5 or above for English-taught Program</li><li>7. Study plan in Japanese or English, and Chinese</li><li>8. Two recommendation letters in English: written by the dean or advising professor of universities in Taiwan from which the applicant graduated or advising professors of GSA, Kyoto U or employers where they have worked.</li><li>9. Undertaking</li><li>10. Copy of Japan student visa or a copy of their residence card of Japan (both sides)</li><li>11. Copy of discharge order or certificate of exemption from military service for all male applicants</li><li>12. KYC Form</li><li>13. Residential address proof</li><li>14. Bank Account Details</li></ol>
