

Preface

This annual report summarizes the activities of education and research at the Graduate School/Faculty of Agriculture, Kyoto University, in the school year 2005, as a part of self-inspection and self-evaluation. This Graduate School/Faculty is comprised of 7 divisions (Agronomy and Horticultural Science, Forest and Biomaterials Science, Applied Life Sciences, Applied Biosciences, Environmental Science and Technology, Natural Resource Economics, and Food Science and Biotechnology), 6 departments (Bioresource Sciences, Applied Life Sciences, Agricultural and Environmental Engineering, Food and Environmental Economics, Forest and Biomaterials Science, and Food Science and Biotechnology), Experimental Farm, and Livestock Farm.
